I. Introduction.

- A. One of the basic responsibilities of a leader is to equip laborers to be their best for Christ in their own personal lives. (Ephesians 4:11, Mark 4)
- B. Christ sent the Apostles out with the intent of making and maturing disciples.
- C. Jesus viewed the crowds as a shepherd-less bewildered flock and as a harvest (Matthew 9:36-38, Matthew 23, John 4:34)
- D. The answer to the harvest is the laborer.
 - 1. A laborer is a common worker.
 - 2. A laborer is launched out into the harvest.

II. Challenges to laboring.

- A. What is wrong with the harvest it is hard work. We must acknowledge that we will never own the field. (Colossians 1:29)
- B. There is a problem with the harvest there will be difficulties such as rejection. (Matthew 10:1, 10:14)
 - 1. The problems is that the world preaches comfort.
 - 2. If something is easy, it does not necessarily mean that it is right.
- III. Jesus was a laboring supervisor. (Matthew 11:1, John 9:4, Galatians 4:19, 1 Thessalonians 1:3, 5:12, 1 Timothy 5:17)
 - A. There cannot be any room for a lazy man in the work of Christ.
 - B. The disciples "addicted" themselves to the work of laboring. (1 Corinthians 16:15-16)
- IV. It was always Christ through us that we can be a laborer. (Romans 15:18-19)
 - A. We can only rely on the Spirit for effective power to witness. (1 Corinthians 2:2-3)\
 - B. The success of the witness depends upon the Spirit we must rely completely on God and live under His control. (2 Corinthians 10:4)
