- I. Introduction.

- II. The people were given the sign of Jonah (Matthew 12:38-39; 16:4)
 - A. God called Jonah to go to Nineveh, but he resisted. (Jonah)
 - 1. Nineveh heard of Jonah's reluctance through communication lines.
 - 2. Instead of going to Nineveh, Jonah got a ticket to go to Spain in the opposite direction.
 - 3. Every hour he traveled to Tarsus, he got closer to Nineveh.
 - B. There was a great storm and Jonah was forced to repent after the cargo was dumped.
 - 1. The owner of the ship rode the ship. (Acts 27:11)
 - 2. The sailors probably went to port and they talked. Word likely got back to Nineveh.
 - 3. The Ninevites never got the message.
 - C. Jonah was only delayed.
 - 1. Jonah prayed in the belly of the fish.
 - 2. Jonah lost oxygen and was in Hades the place of the dead. It is in the center of the earth.

- 3. No wonder there was revival in Nineveh. They were a wicked people and they saw judgment. They heard that Jonah was dead. When they saw Jonah it had an effect on them a resurrection effect.
- D. The message: God loved Nineveh when Nineveh did not love God.

III. The evidence of God in the resurrection is better than the power of Elijah for testimony. There is no post-Easter season; it is always about the resurrection.
