- Why? 1. Jesus commanded us to make disciples. Matt 28:19
 - 2. Church is under attack Consider this dual purpose:
 - A. Make disciples
 - B. Your availability to God can overcome the devil's attacks on the Church or Split it over petty issues. The more disciples the stronger the Church.
- How? 1. Examine your motive. Go in a spirit of humility. I Cor. 10:31
 - 2. Don't go in your own strength. John 15:5
 - 3. Be sure you're involved in and are reviewing the basics of the Christian Life yourself. II Tim 2:15
 - 4. Remember you're there to serve. Mark 10:45
 - 5. Remember the life lived in Christ is your greatest influence. Matt 5:16
 - 6. The Senior Pastor is the key.
 - A. Assure him you are no threat or to take anyone out of the Church.
 - B. Work within the framework given you.
 - C. Ask if you can have a home Bible Study.
 - D. Share with him the material you intend to use.
 - E. Keep him informed.
 - F. Invite him to attend.
 - 7. Contribute time and money to the Church.
 - 8. Don't be over committed. Remember if you have a family or profession, they come before ministry.

- 9. Expect success from God's perspective but also expect opposition.
- 10. When God blesses, avoid the trap of pride. God gets the glory.
- 11. Know how and where to "fish for men"- Matt. 4:19
- 12. Be patient! Don't be discouraged. Persevere. Heb 10:36
- 13. Stay prayed up. Eph 4: 6,7 & John 16:24
- 14. Hold very loosely to your preferences, very tightly to absolutes.
- 15. Be yourself Don't restrict the Spirit working in your life.
