What is Recruiting?

(As used here, we mean recruiting people to be and to make disciples)

Recruiting is the process of helping people, as a servant of God and of others, to move from their current spiritual state to maturity in Christ.

Tasks of the Recruiter

- Relate to him/her
- Assess his/her current state
- Listen to him/her
- Communicate
 - 1. Interest
 - 2. Enthusiasm
 - 3. Next steps
- Assess response to you and God's Word

Skills Needed by the Recruiter

- Relational Skills—engaging, interesting, interested, energetic, listening, etc.
- Communication Skills—ability to communicate effectively, to motivate, to adapt to the individual and to different personalities/learning styles/other characteristics
- Word Skills—knowledge of the Bible, of how to understand it and of how to use it
