- I. Introduction. Text: Colossians 3:12-17.
- II. The Christian experience is described as putting chosen qualities on and taking off the negative ones.
  - A. These qualities are reflected by the work and life of Jesus.
  - B. Every morning these qualities should be put on.
  - C. We can put these qualities on because we are new persons in Christ.
  - D. We are to consider ourselves dead in Christ, and we can because God has given us a new basis of operation in Christ. (Romans 6)
- III. The qualities to put on.
  - A. Compassion.
    - 1. This refers to sympathy.
    - 2. It is a heart of pity.
  - B. Kindness. This is compassion in action.
  - C. Humility.
    - 1. This is the chief virtue of the Christian.
    - 2. We are to consider others as better than ourselves.
  - D. Gentleness.
    - 1. This is meekness.
    - 2. This is also strength under control.
    - 3. Meekness is to set aside one's rights for others.
  - E. Patience.
    - 1. This is the endurance of another's exacerbating conduct.
    - 2. It is holding oneself back.
  - F. Forbearance. This is to uphold one another.
  - G. Forgiveness.

- 1. We are to forgive as the Lord forgave us.
- 2. This does not mean we are never to speak of a grievance.
- 3. Having spoken the grievance we must let it go.
- 4. Forgiveness means...
  - a. We are not to bring the wrong up again.
  - b. We are not to tell others.
  - c. We do not remind ourselves of the matter.
- H. All these qualities are to be wrapped in love.
  - 1. Love is over everything else.
  - 2. This is the quality of feeling loving towards others because one is a new person.
  - 3. The basis for all of this is that believers are God's people loved and chosen to be holy.
    - a. However, God still has a plan for the Jewish people—the church has all the spiritual blessings. (Romans 11)
    - b. Christians are expected to be different because they are different.
    - c. God loves us deeply. It is amazing to be loved by God.
- IV. The qualities of the church functioning together.
  - A. Peace.
    - 1. Peace ruling means that peace makes decisions.
    - 2. The church is to be in control.
  - B. Praise.
    - 1. Christians are to have an attitude of gratitude.
    - 2. They are to have this attitude because they know they do not deserve anything.
  - C. Precepts.
    - 1. The Word is to be well known and the center of our lives.
    - 2. The whole body is to be involved in sharing the Word to one another.
    - 3. The truth that comes from the Word is alive and illuminating.

- 4. The ministry of music is linked with the sharing of the Word. As we sing we minister to each other.
- V. The whole of life is to be related to the Lordship of Jesus.
