I. Introduction.

- A. Sexual morality is one of the great challenges of the day.
- B. It was a problem in ancient times too. (Romans 1)
- C. Text: Ephesians 5.
- D. The Christian position is diametrically opposed to sexual immorality. The Bible makes it clear that faithfulness to a partner or abstinence is key.
- II. Reasons why sexual looseness is incompatible with the Christian life.
 - A. Sexual looseness is incompatible with Christianity because sexual looseness is defiling and debasing of humanity.
 - 1. Christians are not permitted to talk about distortions of sex.
 - 2. This does not mean that Christians are not permitted to talk about sex.
 - 3. God's prohibitions in this regard are to keep us for something helpful and good.
 - 4. Sex may be a bodily urge, but that does not mean it is not to be regulated.
 - 5. Sex must be regulated by marriage.
 - 6. It is both a physical and psychological union.
 - 7. Sexual looseness is a violation of love. You cannot test the efficacy of a marriage by sex before marriage.
 - B. Even the talk that leads to sexual looseness is not fitting—it is useless.
 - 1. When we expose ourselves to these forces, our drive breaks over its boundaries.
 - 2. The facts teach us that the current studies on sex have only increased abuses.
