 - a. The Word coming through Jesus was more inclusive than that which came through the prophets.
 - b. Jesus is God's final word to man.
 - c. Jesus forms the boundaries of history.
 - 1) He is the terminating point—all things will end in Him. (Matthew 24)
 - 2) All things began in Him as the Creator of the world.
 - d. Jesus made purification for sins making provision for what was destroying human life.
 - 2. He has a greater name than the angels do.
 - a. He is greater because of His relationship to God as His Son.
 - b. The angels worship Him.
 - c. His words move with authority. (Psalm 110)
 - d. Jesus is the originator and the sustainer of all.
 - e. The angels are servants, but the Son is God.
 - 3. Christ is a surer Word than the Law is.
 - a. We need to pay attention.
 - b. This message is particularly valid.
