- I. Introduction.
  - A. Text: I John 3:10.
  - B. Theme: maintaining righteousness in a wicked world.
- II. The secret of maintaining righteousness is having the Righteous One live in a person.
  - A. Everyone who does right is born of Him.
  - B. There is a great mystery to life. What we shall be has not appeared yet.
- III. Humanity is divided into two classes: the children of the devil and the children of God.
  - A. Being children of the devil means one reflects his characteristics.
  - B. Being children of God means one reflects His characteristics.
  - C. Man is a vessel—we were made for God.
  - D. Because of the fall, man is expressing the perverted life of the devil.
    - 1. We were born children of the devil because we are descendents of Adam who sold himself to the devil.
    - 2. Only the kingdom of God frees one from the kingdom of the devil.
  - E. Becoming children of God is an act of God.
    - 1. This life cannot be lost.
    - 2. However, many people think they are children of God when they are not.
      - a. Many "convert" for temporary comfort—this is not a true conversion.
      - b. One can tell whether conversion is real by whether a person loves and begins to depart from sin.
      - c. The one who is born again cannot continue in  $\sin$  because the life in him says, "No!"
      - d. There are certain things you cannot do or say and be a child of God.
      - e. Admission has been secretly gained into the church by the ungodly that pervert God's grace into licentiousness. (Jude)
