- 4. Make a fearless and searching moral inventory of yourself
- 5. Admitted to God, to ourselves and to another human being the exact nature of our sin pattern. Get a mentor/cheerleader/champion
- 6. Be ready for God to remove your problem. Accept the grace that is freely yours
- 7. Humbly ask God to remove our shortcomings and areas of weakness. Plan for a bad day. When you mess up, start over.
- 8. Make a list of all the persons you have harmed and be ready to make amends
- Make direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others
- 10. Continued to take personal inventory and when we were wrong promptly admitted it
- 11. Seek through prayer and meditation on God's Word to improve our relationship with God, praying only for knowledge of God's will for us and the power to carry that out
- 12. Help someone else do the same
