B. Available. We must cut off entanglements. (II Timothy 2:3-4, Hebrews 12:1-2, John 15)

C. Interdependent. We must have a healthy relationship alone and with the body of Christ. (I Corinthians 10:18; 4:11; 14:3)

D. Teachable. (Acts 18:24-28)

E. Holy. (II Corinthians 11:1, Hebrews 12:14)
