#### I Introduction.

# II. Apostles. (Luke 6:13)

- C. There are no apostles today because no one has seen Jesus today.

- C. We do not need prophets today because we have the Word of Prophecy. (Ephesians 2:19)
- IV. Teacher. This is one who explains and applies the Word of God.

### V. Evangelists.

- B. Everyone has this mission, but some are especially gifted at it.

- B. Miracles did not always win people over. (1 Corinthians 1)
