II. We must take heed to ourselves. (Acts 20:28; Hebrews 10:31; Psalm 50:16-17)

- A. We must live what we preach. (Mark 4:19)
- B. We need to be adequately prepared to minister.

D. Watch out for authoritarianism.

V. We must be men of vision.

A. God wants us to see first and foremost himself.

B. God wants us to see the lost. (Matthew 9)

C. God wants us to see the world. (Revelation 5:9)

D. God wants us to see things from God's point of view. (Colossians 1; 1 Peter 1:6-7; Isaiah 30:20; Psalm 133:1; Galatians 5:22-23; 1 Corinthians 13:4-7; 2 Peter 1:4-8; James 3:7; John 13:34)

E. God wants us to have a vision of our own.

F. God wants men of vision who have nonnegotiable convictions. (Acts 20:24; 5:29)

G. God wants men who have the Great Commission as part of their vision. (Mark 16:15)

H. Vision helps us to focus our lives.

I. Real vision provides meaning and purpose. (Proverbs 29:18; Job 42; Acts 27:21ff; Matthew 27; 2 Corinthians 4:16-18; Isaiah 9:2; Psalm 130:6; 30:5)
